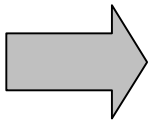


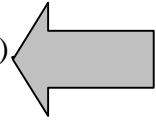
2nd Southeast Workshop on Soft Materials and Interfaces

Emory University – Georgia Institute of Technology
Saturday, October 25, 2008

Overview: This workshop will bring together researchers with an interest in soft materials, molecular forces, biophysics, molecular electronics, and fluid dynamics, to discuss their work and explore collaborations. At this workshop we will have four invited talks. The rest of the time will be allotted to short “soundbite” presentations, intended to give the audience a flavor for the research topic and techniques used. We hope and expect that students will attend whether or not their faculty advisors can attend. The workshop will last most of the day, and include lunch and coffee breaks to encourage discussions. This is the second in this series of workshops, which are intended to occur twice a year, alternating between Georgia Tech and Emory.
